UNCLE JOHN'S GRAVEL RACE – RACE DAY SCHEDULE OF EVENTS AND INFORMATION

Parking, registration, start, finish, and awards will all take place at the Uncle John's Cider Mill, 8614 US-127, St Johns, MI 48879. Packet pick-up is available Friday night (9/12) from 4pm-7pm & again on Saturday (9/13) beginning at 7:00am.

PARKING

When turning into the entrance of Uncle John's Cider Mill drive all the way to the back of the parking area. This is where everything for the gravel race will happen. Please see the "Race grounds Map" on our website for more guidance. **DO NOT** park near the buildings and barns on the West side of the property. This is meant for customers that only want to go to the Cider Mill.

BEDLAM BICYCLE COMPANY is our Official Bike Shop. Bedlam will be on hand on race day for repairs and adjustments at no charge. If you need parts, you MUST pay for them at the time of service. On course bike support will be provided by Diane Ruggles, whose contact information will be on the back of your race number plate.

RACE STAGING – As you enter the staging area, we ask that the faster riders start in the front and slower riders start near the back. As you enter the start finish area, you will see signs with anticipated average race speeds. The first sign you will see is 0-12 mph, followed by 13-15 mph, 16-18mph, 19-21 mph and finally at the start line 22+ mph. Please line up behind the appropriate sign for your anticipated speed. A few minutes before the actual start, we will have everyone move up / or close any gaps between the signs for the start. Please do not stage your bike in the start area until staging opens for your race distance.

RULES - Safety should always be on your mind. Yes, this is a race, but it please think of your safety as well as your competitors' safety when competing in this event.

- Do not fold, bend, curve, or alter race number plates in any way. The number with the computer chip sticker on the back must be tied to the front of your bike without bending it so that it can be read. If altered you are subject to being disqualified.
- ELECTRIC/MOTOR ASSISTED BIKES are not allowed because of drafting advantage concerns for other riders.
- NO aero bars (Great for time trials, but become dangerous when riding in a pack if a crash occurs)
- Any rider who follows/drafts a motor vehicle will be disqualified
- Helmets are mandatory for this event.
- NO headphones allowed while riding. You need to hear what is going on around you in this event.
- IT IS THE RACER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO FOLLOW THE MAP AND KNOW THEIR COURSE. The entire course is marked with directional signs, paint arrows on the edge of the road, and confidence dots painted on the side of the road after a turn. Corner worker volunteers and Law Enforcement will also be present on some corners and/or intersections on the racecourse to direct you, but it is ultimately your responsibility to stay on the route. We encourage all riders to study their maps and download the course maps for navigation computers beforehand.
- Although considered a race, riders must still follow Michigan laws of the roads. This includes stopping at **stop** signs.
- For safety reasons we ask the slower riders to move towards the right side of the roadway and yield to the group of riders behind them. This is for the safety of both the faster and slower groups of riders. Racers who are not part of the lead group are asked to call out to slower riders and advise them of your passing intentions prior to overtaking them. The most accepted way of doing this is to call out "ON YOUR LEFT" as you approach a slower rider.
- For safety as well as courtesy to your fellow riders, if you have to stop and walk your bike up a hill, please do this on the right side of the road and leave the left open for those very fast climbers.
- Fat Tire Bikes To qualify for the division your tires must be at least 3.7 inches (94mm) wide.
- You must also be present for the awards presentation to receive your awards. We will not send awards to you after the race.
